1997 Ft Myers Knife Club Knife
The Ft Myers Knife Club knife for 1997 is a Bulldog Elephant Toenail on Appaloosa smooth bone. The original knife received by the club had only **ONE BULLDOG** (now placeholder) between the club members that the knives would reflect the old work of **TWO BULLDOGS**. After receiving the discrepancy, the Parker and the club president, Ken Rabolden, came up with a unique solution. For the following Parker offered a plan that for every member who requested a **TWO BULLDOG** knife, an additional charge of ten dollars be added. Since the members' knife is genuine and replace the main blade so that it will reflect **TWO BULLDOGS** and later the main blade with **ONE BULLDOG**, giving the member a unique **TRANSITION** knife that will never be duplicated. He would also retain to the member the original master blade taken from the original knife for his collection. This offer was a resolution deal and would not be offered again. One of the original 19 knives plus (2) Transition (1) of the knives and (1) Parker type were assigned to the Parker for small donation. Displayed in this case is one of these knives and it's the first number 19.
